

Block of the Month: June 2008

To Rotary Cut Pieces:

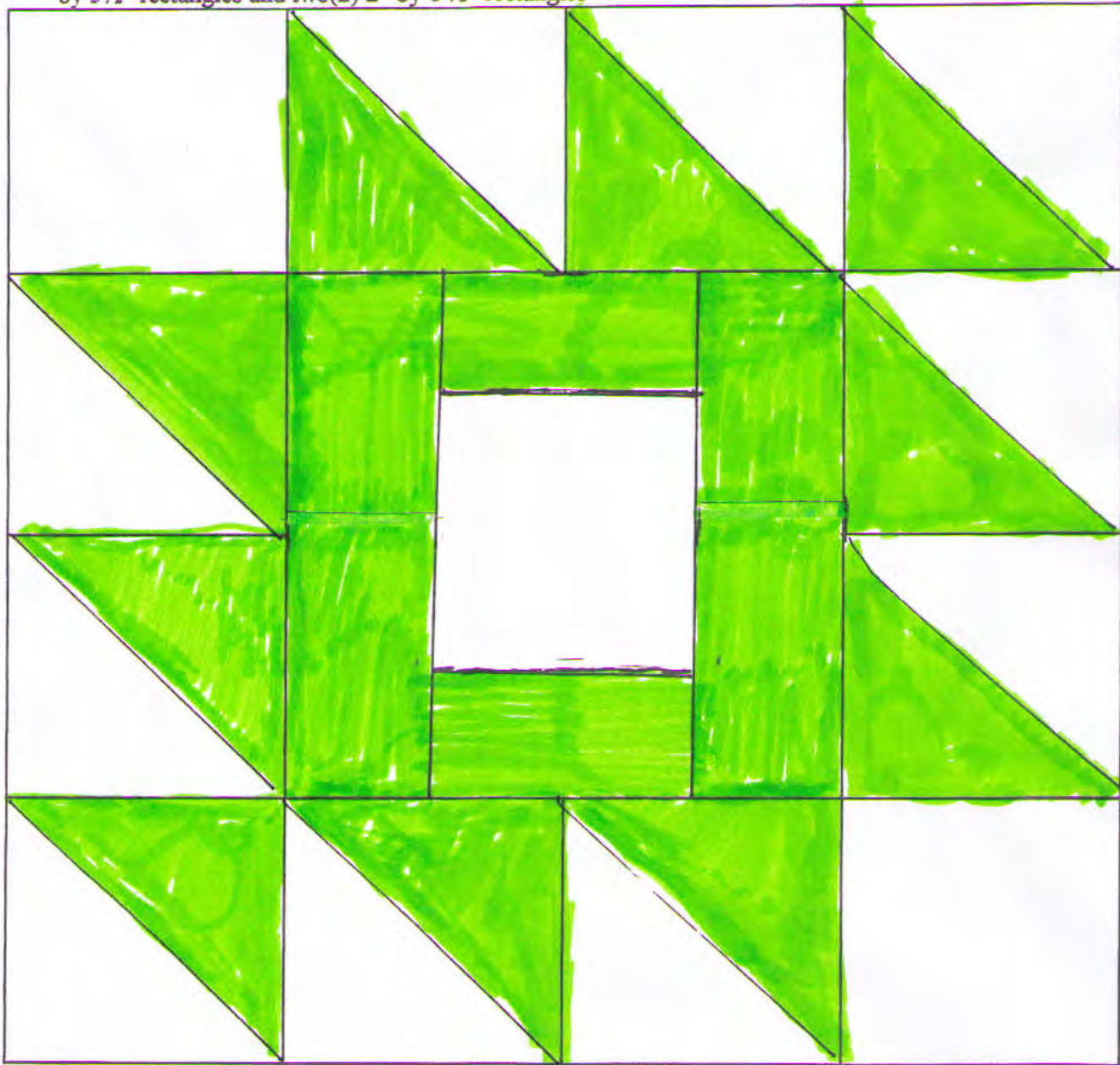
From White cut Five (5) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and Three (3) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From Pastel Fabric cut Five (5) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, two (2) $2"$ by $3\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangles and two (2) $2"$ by $6\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangles

Colors:

White

Color: Pastel (solid or print)



Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the back of each White $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Place each White Square on top of a Pastel $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square, right sides together. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}"$ on either side of the diagonal line.

Step 2: Cut along the diagonal line and press the seam to the Pastel Color fabric square. Make ten (10) half square triangle units.

Step 3: Sew the 4 rectangles to one $3\frac{1}{2}"$ square, making the center as shown in diagram above. Sew the 10 half square triangles and remaining four $3\frac{1}{2}"$ squares to the center as shown in the diagram above.

Step 5: Press, trim to $12\frac{1}{2}"$ square.
