

# Block of the Month: How Does My Garden Grow?

---

## January 2008: Yellow Rose of Texas

### Colors:

White, Yellow, Green

### Rotary Cut Pieces:

#### From White:

Cut three (3)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and cut seven (7)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

#### From Yellow:

Cut three (3)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and cut three (3)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

#### From Green:

Cut two (2)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

### Putting it together:

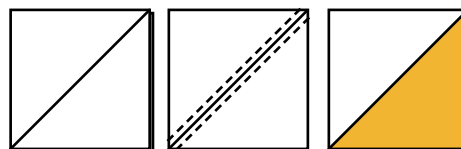
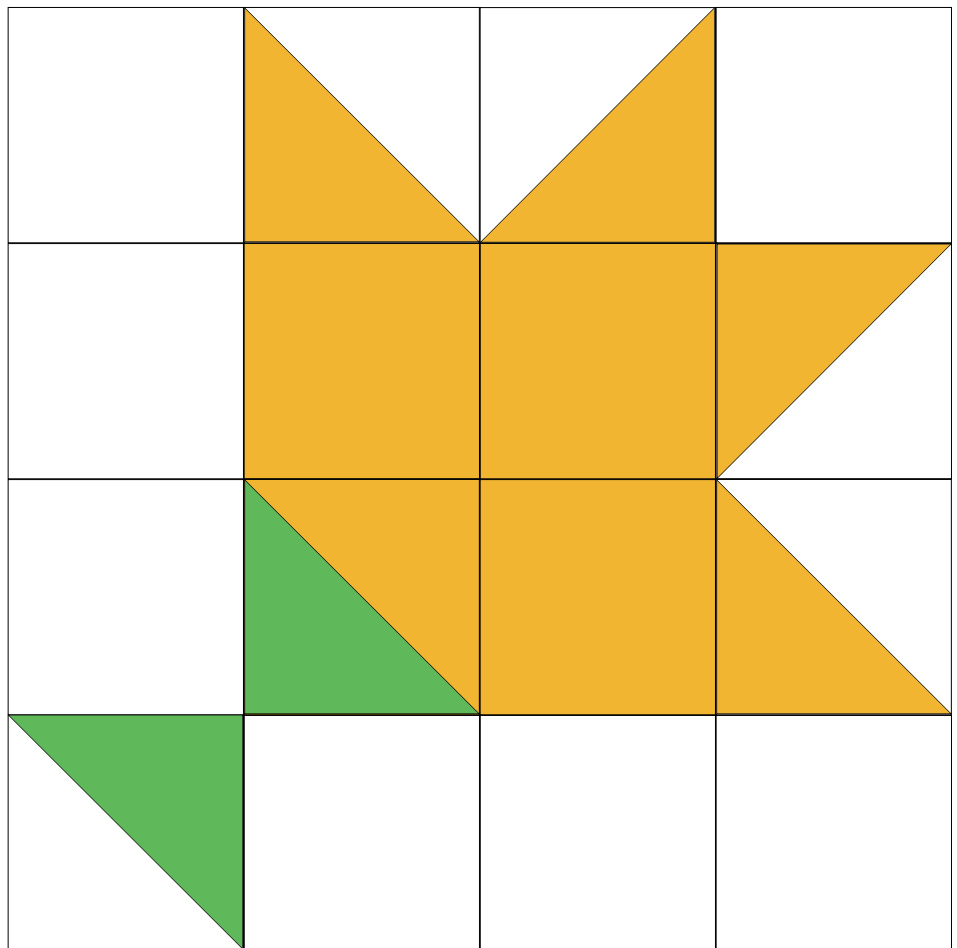
**Step 1:** Draw a diagonal line on the back of three White  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Place two  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " White squares on top of two of the Yellow  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and place one  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " White square on top of the Green  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square, right sides together.

**Step 2:** Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the diagonal line. Cut along the diagonal line and press the seam to the color side. Make (4) yellow and white half square triangle units: and two (2) green and white half square triangle unit.

**Step 3:** Repeat the above with one Yellow  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square and one  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Green square. Make two (2) green and yellow half square triangle units. Note: you will only need one of these units.

**Step 5:** Sew the blocks together as shown in the finished diagram.

**Step 6:** Press, trim to  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
